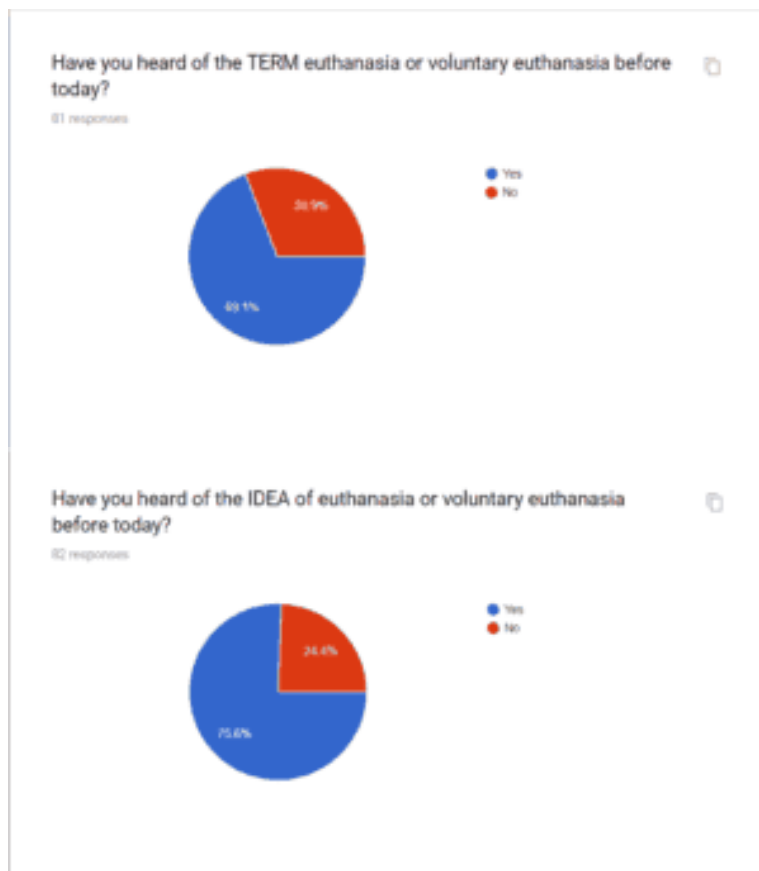


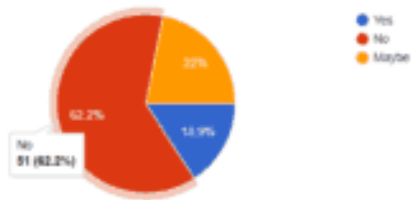


Euthanasia Survey Results



Do you think the procedure should be illegal?

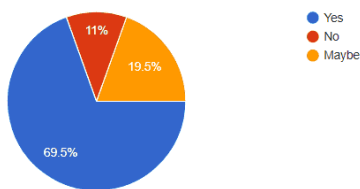

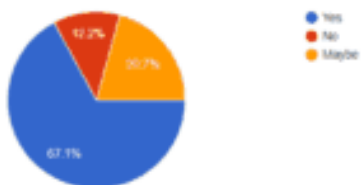

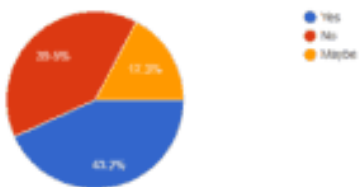

- Once it is deemed terminal it should be an option just like medical options

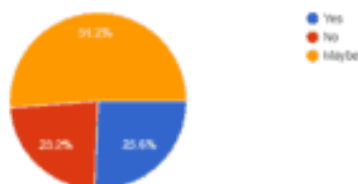
If you answered no to the question above, do you think there should be ANY age limitation? If so what?
