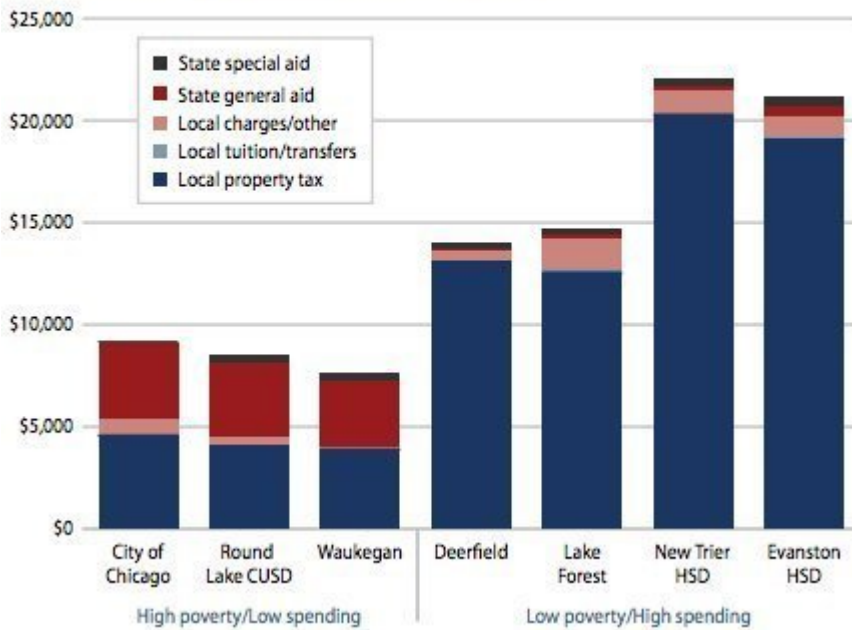


Revenue decomposition (2009-11) of advantaged and disadvantaged school districts in Illinois.
