

How can we Handle Covid-19?

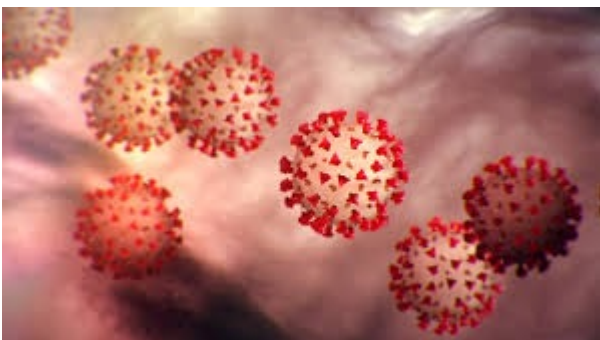
